F. Information

1. Grading systems of the institutions

Courses are graded on a scale from 0 to 10 points. Grades below 5.5 count as a fail. Grades of 5.5 and higher are a pass. The European Credit Transfer System is the exclusive credit system at Fontys. The content of the exchange programme along with the credits are laid down in the Learning Agreement. The period abroad is part of the curriculum and as such fully recognized. A Transcript of Records is being used as a compulsory tool. Apart from these criteria, all Fontys Schools have explicit requirements regarding grades, motivation and competences the student must meet before he/she is allowed to study abroad. All students have a personal study career supervisor who helps them to follow the right procedures.
