RESPONSIBILITIES oF INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- In order for prospective students to obtain residence, they must examine the information available on the web address https://www.goc.gov.tr/ikamet and the fields for the required documents. Residence applications are made by the International Office, as well.
- Residence permit applications are finalized no later than ninety days after the application is processed. Therefore, it is important for the candidate students to apply for a residence as soon as possible.
- To renew their residence permit, students who are enrolled, and who want to extend their residence during their education, must submit the required documents to the International Office 60 days before the specified time in writing.
- In order for prospective students to obtain Equivalency Certificate; Documents required by the Turkish Provincial Directorate of National Education should be prepared for application. If the residence permit, residence permit application document or university / school acceptance certificate is missing, the application cannot be made.
- The REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE AND DOCUMENTS field for Equivalency, which is included in our E-SERVICES at http://istanbul.meb.gov.tr, needs to be examined.
- According to the Application and Registration Directive of Foreign Students for IKU
 Associate Degree and Language Programs; Prospective students are required to provide their GPA in the High School Transcript documents.
- For students enrolled in Turkish-medium programs / departments; Turkish Language
 Proficiency Levels should be as follows,

- C1 and C2 Level: Turkish language level is sufficient. They can start their education in the department.
- 2. B1 and B2 Level: Turkish language level is likely to improve in a short time. They can start their education in the department.
- 3. A1 and A2 Level: Turkish language level is insufficient. Students who are enrolled in the Turkish-medium programs are required to study at the Turkish Preparatory Department for a fee until B1 Level is achieved. Students whose Turkish proficiency level cannot reach B1 level at the end of two semesters and fail in the Compulsory at the Turkish Preparatory Class cannot continue their education. At the end of this period, the student who cannot meet the conditions is dismissed from the University.
- Students enrolled in English-medium programs/Departments who fail in the Compulsory Preparatory Class at the end of two academic years cannot continue their education. At the end of this period, the student who cannot fulfil the conditions is dismissed from the University.
- Prospective students are required to complete the documents required for the registration in the Application and Registration Directive of Foreign Students for IKU Associate Degree and Language Programs.
- Students who fail to receive an equivalence certificate will not be able to take courses and will be dismissed from the University.
