- 2. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

- 1. Erasmus applications for incoming students on-line https://tiss.tuwien.ac.at/mobility
- 2. TU Wien will send its invitation letter within 4 weeks after the official nomination of the candidate by the home institution.
- 3. Students can download and print out their official Transcript of Records from "TU Wien Information Services" (TISS) within 5 weeks after the exam.

# 4. Termination of the agreement

In the event of termination or amendment of this agreement by either party notice will be given by October of the preceding year. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 October 2015 will only take effect as of 1 October 2016. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
